MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS FOR APPOINTMENT TO THE POST OF ASSISTANT PROFESSOR IN COLLEGES AS PER UGC REGULATIONS 2018 and G.R.dated 14th November 2018 and 8th March 2019.

A.

- A Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned/relevant/allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test. accredited by UGC like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a PhD degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET.

Provided the candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances / Bye-laws / Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/ Institutions subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:

- The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in regular mode only;
- The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two examiners;
- An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
- The candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a refereed journal; and



- v. The candidate has presented at least two papers, based on his/her Ph.D. work in conferences/seminars, sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC/ ICSSR/CSIR or any similar agency.

Note:

1. The fulfillment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic affairs) of the University concerned.
2. NET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SET is not conducted. However, Ph.D. degree shall remain the minimum eligibility for appointment of Assistant Professor in such disciplines.

(B)

The Ph.D. degree has been obtained from a foreign university/institution with a ranking among top 500 in the World University Ranking (at any time) by any one of the following:

1. Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) ;
 2. the Times Higher Education (THE) or
 3. the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai).
- A relaxation of 5% shall be provided (from 55% to 50% of the marks) to the Ph.D Degree holders, who have obtained their Master's Degree prior to 19th September, 1991.
- A relevant grade which is regarded as equivalent of 55% wherever the grading system is followed by a recognized university, at the Master's level shall also be considered valid.
- A relaxation of 5% shall be allowed at the Bachelor's as well as at the Master's level for the candidates belonging to scheduled caste/scheduled tribe/Other Backward classes (OBC) (Non-Creamy Layer)/Differently-abled (a) Blindness and low vision;(b) Deaf and Hard of Hearing; (c) Locomotor disability including cerebral palsy, leprosy cured, dwarfism, acid-attack victims and muscular dystrophy; (d)Autism, intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental illness; (e) Multiple disabilities from amongst persons under (a) to (d) including deaf-blindness) for the purpose of eligibility and assessing good academic record for recruitment. The eligibility marks 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever the grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based only on the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedure.
- Remuneration will be given to appointed candidate as per Government Resolution reference sankirna- 2018 (185/18) ma.shi.3 dt. 14.11.2018



- v. The candidate has presented at least two papers, based on his/her Ph.D. work in conferences/seminars, sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC/ICSSR/CSIR or any similar agency.

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
